None appeared on behalf of the petitioners, nor any intimation of their absence was received.

A perusal of the prayer clause reveals that the petitioners seek directions against the official respondents to refrain from causing harassment and further seek protection of their lives and liberties.

It is a settled proposition of law, as laid down by this Court in *Abdul Hameed and another v. Province of Sindh and others* (PLD 2019 Sindh 168), and reiterated in *C.P. No. S-482 of 2025 (Manzoor Ali v. Province of Sindh and others)*, that a constitutional petition seeking protection is not directly maintainable before this Court where an adequate and efficacious alternate remedy is available under the law and has not been availed. The aggrieved person is first required to approach the competent forum having jurisdiction in the matter.

In the present case, the record reflects that the petitioners have not approached the concerned forum or authority competent to grant the relief sought. Therefore, the instant petition suffers from the defect of maintainability and

has been filed without first exhausting the alternate remedy available under the law.

Accordingly, this petition, being not maintainable and suffering from want of jurisdiction, is dismissed in limine.
