The record reflects that after 5.12.2025, neither the petitioners nor their learned counsel have appeared to pursue the matter. Even today, when the case is called, none appeared on their behalf, nor any intimation regarding their absence is received. It appears that the petitioners are no longer interested in prosecuting the instant petition.

A perusal of the prayer clause reveals that the petitioners seek directions against the official respondents not to cause harassment and further seek protection of their lives and liberties.

It is by now well settled through the judgments of this Court in *Abdul Hameed and another v. Province of Sindh and others* (PLD 2019 Sindh 168) and *C.P. No. S-482 of 2025 (Manzoor Ali v. Province of Sindh and others)* that harassment petitions are not directly maintainable before this Court where an adequate and efficacious alternate remedy is available under the law. In such circumstances, the aggrieved person is required to first approach the competent forum having jurisdiction in the matter.

The record further reflects that the petitioners have not approached the concerned forum competent to grant the relief sought. Therefore, the instant petition is not maintainable and suffers from want of jurisdiction.

Accordingly, the instant petition is dismissed in limine, being not maintainable under the law as well as for non-prosecution.
