Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not press the instant petition.

Perusal of the record reflects that the petition pertains to the alleged harassment of the petitioner and seeks protection. The issue involved is squarely covered by the dictum laid down by the Honourable Division Bench of this Court in *Abdul Hameed and another v. Province of Sindh and others* (PLD 2019 Sindh 168), and is further in line with the judgment passed by this Court in C.P. No. S-482 of 2025 (*Manzoor Ali v. Province of Sindh and others*), wherein it has been held that constitutional petitions seeking protection and restraint against alleged harassment are not maintainable where an alternate remedy is available under the law.

In view of the submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner that he does not press the petition, and keeping in view the legal position discussed above, the instant petition is dismissed as not pressed and, otherwise, being not maintainable in law.
