Statement/Report filed on behalf of respondents No.02 and 06 is taken on record. Mr. Ali Akbar Solangi, Advocate, has filed Vakalatnama on behalf of respondents No.03 to 05, which is also taken on record.

Mr. Muhammad Afzal Jagirani, Advocate, holds brief for Mr. Ashfaq Hussain Abro, Advocate for the petitioner, and submits that the learned counsel is engaged before another Bench of this Court.

The record has been perused. It appears that the instant petition pertains to the alleged harassment of the petitioner. However, nothing has been brought on record to demonstrate that the petitioner had previously availed the statutory remedy available before the learned Justice of Peace. The record is conspicuously silent in this regard.

It is a settled principle of law that where an adequate and efficacious remedy is available under the law, the constitutional jurisdiction of this Court ordinarily ought not to be invoked. Reference in this regard may be made to the dictum laid down in PLD 2019 Sindh 168.

In view of the above, the instant Constitutional Petition, being not maintainable at this stage, is dismissed.
