Applicant Muhammad Imran Ameen seeks pre-arrest arrest bail in Crime No.606 of 2025 registered by PS Gizri, Karachi under Section 408, 420 PPC. Earlier, his request for pre arrest bail was declined by the learned Additional Sessions Judge-II, Karachi South, vide order dated 20.12.2025.

As per the FIR, Muhammad Imran Ameen, a Verification Officer at Qist Bazaar, allegedly created over 30 fake customer accounts and misappropriated Rs. 3,000,000. It is alleged that 22 of these accounts were linked to a dishonoured cheque issued by Mirza Usama Baig, resulting in a separate FIR. The FIR further alleges that Imran admitted his wrongdoing, sought time to repay the amount, was found with a cash book, and was later terminated from service. After his termination, he allegedly defamed the company on social media, leading to the registration of the present FIR.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties. My observations and findings are as follows.

A person who disappeared from the trial and against whom proceedings under section 87 and 88 Cr.P.C. have been initiated has come seeking pre-arrest bail. No justification for why he is an absconder from trial has been given. The bail application is dismissed. The applicant shall surrender himself to custody and then seek post arrest bail if so advised.
