The case of the complainant is that on 16.04.2024, he advanced Rs. 20,30,000/- to applicant Kamran Khan for business purposes. In return, Kamran Khan issued Cheque No. 58765402 drawn on Bank Alfalah, Block-H Nazimabad Branch, assuring repayment within 45 days. The complainant presented the cheque on 06.06.2024, 11.06.2024, and 20.06.2024, but it was dishonoured each time due to insufficient funds. Despite repeated assurances and requests for time, Kamran Khan failed to repay the amount and has now stopped contacting the complainant.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and have perused the material available on record.

I have gone through the record. There is an agreement of which only one page exists. The second page is not on record. The purpose for which the cheque has been issued will have to be verified at the trial as an offence under Section 489-F PPC would only arise if the cheque has been issued for satisfaction of the loan or fulfilment of an obligation. The offence with which the applicant is charged carries a potential sentence

of three years and thus falls within the non-prohibitory clause of Section 497 Cr.PC. Keeping in view the principles laid down in **Tariq Bashir and 5 others vs The State (PLD 1995 SC 34)**, I do not see any extraordinary or exceptional ground to deny the applicant bail. Accordingly, ad-interim bail earlier granted to the applicant is confirmed on the same terms and conditions.
