O R D E R

Khalid Hussain Shahani, J: - Through this application, the applicant, Shah Nawaz seeks confirmation of interim pre-arrest bail in a case bearing Crime No.415/2025, registered under Sections 452, 506(2), 504, 147, 148, 149, 337-A(i), F(i) P.P.C. at P.S. Shahdadpur, following dismissal of his earlier bail application by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Shahdadpur, vide order dated 26.02.2026.

2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant has been falsely implicated; that an unexplained delay of ten days occurred in lodging the F.I.R; and that the parties are engaged in pending litigation over immovable property. He submits that the applicant's side lodged a prior F.I.R bearing Crime No.206/2025 under Sections 457, 324, 34 P.P.C. at the same police station, following an assault by the complainant's party that caused injuries to the applicant's side, substantiated by medical certificates, photographs, and video recordings on record. He further submits that nine co-accused, facing identical allegations arising from the same occurrence, have already been granted bail by the trial court

and that the applicant is entitled to like treatment on the rule of consistency.

3. Learned D.P.G. for the State and learned counsel for the complainant do not seriously oppose the prayer and concede to confirmation of bail on the ground of parity.

4. Nine co-accused facing identical allegations arising from the same occurrence already stand admitted to bail. The applicant, being similarly placed, is entitled to the same concession on the ground of parity alone. Nothing on record suggests misuse of the bail concession already extended. The application is accordingly allowed, and the interim pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 08.06.2026 is confirmed on the same terms and conditions.

5. The instant Criminal Bail Application stands disposed of in the above terms.
