This petition was disposed of vide order dated 06.12.2023. Thereafter, learned counsel for the petitioner filed an application under Section 151 CPC, bearing CMA No.936 of 2024, on the ground that the order passed by this Court has not been complied with.

Conversely, learned counsel for the respondents contended that the order has already been complied with and that the petitioner's present grievance does not fall within the ambit of the earlier order passed by this Court.

In response, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the decision taken in purported compliance with the order is not in accordance with the law.

Prima facie, if any fresh cause of action has arisen to the petitioner on account of the subsequent decision taken by the respondents, the petitioner may avail an appropriate remedy in accordance with law through independent proceedings. The same,

however, cannot be agitated by way of the present application under Section 151 CPC.

Accordingly, this application, being devoid of merit, is hereby dismissed. Order accordingly.
