Ms. Humaira Jatoi, learned counsel for Sindh Building Control Authority (SBCA), who is present in Court in connection with other cases, waives notice on behalf of SBCA and claims copy of instant petition along with annexures, which is provided to her. After going through the same, she informs the Court that the Authority has introduced a Smart Complaint Redressal Mechanism (SCRM), along with an Appellate Committee, for redressal of grievances of the nature raised by the petitioner. She submits that the petitioner may approach the competent authority by filing an appropriate application/complaint through the SCRM portal, which shall be entertained and decided in accordance with law and applicable SOPs.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, in view of the availability of the aforesaid alternate remedy, submits that the petitioner has no objection to availing the same and to disposal of instant petition accordingly.

In view of above, and without entering into or expressing any opinion on merits of the controversy, Respondent Nos.2 and 3 are directed to decide complaint of the petitioner available at page-23 of the Court file, in accordance with the prescribed procedure and applicable SOPs. The competent authority shall, after affording a fair opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as all other concerned/affected parties, decide

application/complaint, preferably within a period of Forty-five (45) days from the date of receipt of this order, strictly in accordance with law and the applicable Rules/SOPs, through a reasoned order. The decision so taken shall be communicated to all concerned without unnecessary delay.

Accordingly, instant petition is **disposed of** along with all pending applications without expressing any opinion on merits of the petitioner's claim.

Needless to observe that if any party remains aggrieved by decision of the competent authority, it shall be at liberty to avail such remedy as may be available under the law.

Office shall transmit a copy of this order to the Director General, Sindh Building Control Authority, through available expeditious mode for information and compliance. Learned MIT-II shall ensure compliance.
