- 2-4. Through this petition, petitioner has made the following prayers:

*“It is, therefore, very respectfully prayed on behalf of the petitioner above-named that this Honorable Court may graciously be pleased to quash the impugned FIR No. 454/2026 Under Section 420/406 PPC with Boat Basin Police Station to secure the ends of justice.*

*It is further submitted that this Honorable Court may kindly be pleased to quash all the proceedings arising in FIR No. 454/2026 under Section 420/406 PPC with Boat Basin Police Station before any concerned Court of law.*

*It is further submitted that this Honorable Court may kindly be pleased to direct the Respondent No. 2 to 5 to provide protection to the Petitioner from the hands of the Respondent No. 6 and others in the larger interest of Justice.*

*Any other or further relief(s) which this Honorable Court may deem fit and proper under the circumstances.”*

Per averments of petition, petitioner has prayed for quashment of FIR No. 454/2026 registered under Section 420/406 PPC with Police Station Boat Basin Karachi, however, learned counsel has admitted that challan of subject FIR has been submitted and pending before VIIIth Judicial Magistrate, Karachi-West. Since after submission of challan, remedy arises to the to file proper application before the trial court as is embodied under section 249-A Cr.P.C. hence at this juncture in view of the dicta laid down by Apex Court in case of *Director General, Anti-Corruption Establishment, Lahore and others Vs. Muhammad Akram Khan and others* reported as PLD 2013 SC 401, this petition is not maintainable, which is hereby dismissed in *limine* along with listed applications.
