Mr. Jehangir Hashmi, advocate alongwith applicant/accused

1. Urgency granted.
2. Office objection are deferred.
3. Exemption application is granted subject to all just exceptions.
4. Applicant/accused Obaid Chhapra seeks protective transitory bail in Crime No.989/2026, for offences under Sections 489-F PPC registered at P.S. Sachal, Karachi. It is inter-alia contended that applicant/accused is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. It is contended that the applicant/accused is prepared to surrender before the trial Court but apprehends his arrest at the hands of the police. Serious malafide on the part of the police is alleged.

Without touching merits of the case, **protective bail** for a period of **ten (10) days** from today is granted to applicant/accused Obaid Chhapra son of Hashim Chhapra, subject to his furnishing solvent surety in the sum of **Rs.50,000/= (Rupees Fifty Thousand Only)** and P.R. bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Nazir of this Court. Applicant/accused is directed to surrender before the learned trial Court in the aforesaid crime and join investigation forthwith. This order shall cease to have its effect after expiry of **ten days** from today or when the applicant/accused surrenders before the trial Court which one occurs earlier. It is made clear that in case applicant/accused fails to surrender before trial Court within the aforesaid period his bail bond shall stand forfeited.

Accordingly the petition is disposed of.
