Counsel for Defendant No.2 has submitted a statement,  
in terms of which the parties have agreed solution of their disputes  
on the following terms:

- “1. The expense of line inside the premises of plot will be borne by the industries jointly. The mode of share of each shareholder will be decided by themselves.
2. The line/drain outside plot will be laid by SITE Ltd. and the expenses will be borne by SITE Ltd.
3. The stakeholders were of the view that the bathrooms will be reconstructed and their levels will be raised to dispose the water through gravity. In case gravity flow does not work, the system will be modified and pumping will be provided by the industrialists at their own.
4. The work will be completed within 30 days.
5. The technical advice and equipment for carrying out the work will be provided by SITE Limited, however, the expenses will be borne by stakeholders.
6. It was agreed that line laid inside the premises of factory of Mr. Younus M. Bashir does not pertain to SITE Limited, and has been removed by Mr. Younus M. Bashir does not exist anymore, as it was provided favorably to the neighbours.”

Counsel for the Plaintiff submitted that he is satisfied with the above terms and his clients wish that the instant suit may be disposed of in terms of the statement dated 03.08.2016. Counsel for the Defendant No.1 has also no objection if the suit is disposed of in the above terms.

Accordingly, the instant suit is disposed of by way of compromise in the above terms alongwith all the listed applications, with a caution to ensure that all industrial waste be disposed of as per applicable rules ensuring that no degradation to environment and neighbourhood is caused.
