Muhammad Ali Mazhar, J: Basically the petitioners have approached this court for seeking directions against the respondent No.3 to act upon the decisions of the Departmental Appellate Authority dated 16.06.2016 and 23.09.2016. Basically on 16.06.2016 order was communicated by the Section Officer, Services, General Administration & Coordination Department, Government of Sindh. The Administrative Department was directed by the Chief Secretary, Sindh to take some steps for the redressal of the grievances of the appellant Wajid Ali Solangi (petitioner No.1). Since the order was not complied with, therefore, another letter was issued on 23.09.2016 containing similar directions.

2. The learned A.A.G. invited out attention to parawise comments filed by the respondent No.3 in which in paragraph 5 it is stated that the petitioners have not completed the required five years length of service in BS-17 and they have to clear departmental examination within stipulated period of two years.

3. Here, we are not deciding any controversy in relation to the jurisdiction to the orders passed by the Chief Secretary, Sindh but this is their internal process. The order was communicated but it was not implemented, therefore, the petitioners have approached this court. At this juncture, the learned A.A.G. submitted that the order has been implemented, while the counsel for the petitioners submits that no steps have been taken by the respondent No.2 to implement the directions of the Chief Secretary. As a result of the above discussion, the respondents Nos. 2 and 3 are directed to make all best possible efforts to implement the order of Chief Secretary dated 16.06.2016 within a period of one month. The compliance report shall be submitted through MIT of this court. Petition stands disposed of alongwith pending application.
