This appeal is directed by appellant Piyaro against the Judgment dated 18.05.2015 passed by learned Special Judge (Narcotics) Shaheed Benazirabad whereby the appellant who was already in Jail with effect from 04.12.2012 has been convicted under section 9(c) Control of Narcotic Substance Act 1997, and sentenced to 04 years and 06 months rigorous imprisonment and fine of Rs.20,000/- in case of default in payment of fine he was ordered to suffer S.I. for 05 months more. The appellant was also extended benefit of Section 382-B Cr.P.C.

Appeal was admitted to regular hearing. During the pendency of the Appeal Jail Roll was called. Senior Superintendent Central Prison Hyderabad, vide his letter dated 05.04.2017 has reported that appellant / convict Piyaro s/o Sultan alias Habibullah Khokhar has been released from the Prison on 20.04.2016, on completion of his term and payment of fine.

Despite issuance of the notices through SSP Shaheed Benazirabad appellant Piyaro never turned up to contest the appeal. Judgment of trial court requires no interference by this Court.

Learned D.P.G. submits that since the appellant Piyaro has been released from Central Prison Hyderabad, on completion of period of his sentence, therefore, the appeal has become infructuous.

In the view of above since the appeal has become infructuous and it is accordingly disposed of.
