- 1. Urgent application is granted.
- 2. Exemption granted subject to all just exceptions.
- 3. Learned counsel for the applicant contends that the applicant was granted interim pre-arrest bail vide order dated 06.02.2007 by the learned Special Judge Anti-Corruption (Provincial) Hyderabad. He further contends that after grant of interim pre-arrest bail, applicant has regularly attended the trial Court, but on 21.01.2019, when the matter was called, the applicant could not attend the trial Court as the applicant is a Inspector in Excise Department therefore, he was called on emergency duty by Deputy Director (Admn) at Karachi, however, trial Court at very first instance issued NWB against the applicant and notice to his surety under Section 514 Cr.P.C. He contends that he will be satisfied and not press the instant Criminal Revision Application, if NWB issued against

the applicant may be vacated and applicant is left at liberty to appear before the trial Court for concluding his trial.

Learned Deputy Prosecutor General present in court in some other matters waives notice and recorded his no objection.

In view of the above, the impugned order is set-aside and the NBW issued against the applicant is vacated, the applicant will remain on bail with same surety already furnished by him before the trial Court. Accordingly, the instant Criminal Revision Application is dismissed as not pressed, however, applicant is directed to appear before the trial Court, without fail on each and every date of hearing.
