MUHAMMAD ALI MAZHAR, J. The petitioner has challenged the order dated 22.02.2020 whereby an Election Appeal filed by Mazhar Leghari, advocate (respondent No.4) against Returning Officer and others for Election 2020 of District Bar Association Sanghar was disposed of with direction to the Executive Committee Sindh Bar Council to arrange recounting of votes.

The learned counsel argued that before this order the petitioner had won the election to the post of General Secretary with the lead of one vote, however, after recounting again won with two votes but subsequently 15 votes were rejected consequently he lost the elections. After recounting now the petitioner is aggrieved by recount results for which an appropriate remedy is to file appeal and the learned counsel

himself admitted that he while file an appeal to the Pakistan Bar Council againt for recounting the result. Let him file an appeal. It is expected that if any appeal is filed to Pakistan Bar Council, the same shall be decided within a period of one month after providing an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and other stakeholders.
