**ORDER**

**ADNAN-UL-KARIM MEMON, J.-** This writ petition by the petitioner, Muhammad Arshad is primarily, directed against his purported harassment and intimidation / threats to him by the Private respondents in respect of land/ plot situated in Ghulshan-e-Shahbaz Housing Society, Hyderabad. The petitioner stated that private respondents are causing unnecessary harassment to him and disturbing in the lawful possession of subject land/ plots in the aforesaid society. Petitioner has averred that the official respondents are doing nothing as such the petitioner is suffering from trouble. The petitioner alleged that his harassment and humiliation, even continued, therefore, her wife had to move an application under section 22-A Cr.P.C before the learned Sessions judge Jamshoro for legal protection, and to restrain the private respondents from their illegal and unconstitutional harassment, but to no avail; hence the instant writ petition.

2. Arguments heard, and record perused.

3. The petitioner alleged his harassment and intimidation by the private respondents, for which the petitioner has recourse under the law. I am not impressed by the position taken by the learned counsel representing the petitioner that this court can take cognizance of the matter in private affairs of the parties. The assertion, so made, prima-facie is misconceived and is hereby discarded.

4. I have noticed that the family of the petitioner has already resorted the remedy by filling an application under section 22-A (6), Cr.P.C and an appropriate directions have already been issued by learned Ex-officio Justice of Peace vide order dated 11.8.2020 and the remedy against non-compliance of the aforesaid directions is still available under the law.

5. For what has been discussed above, this petition fails and is dismissed in limine along with pending applications, leaving the petitioner at liberty to avail and exhaust the remedy as provided under the law.
