Irshad Ali Shah J.- It is alleged that the applicant with rest of the culprits after having formed an unlawful assembly and in prosecution of their common object by committing trespass into house of complainant Muhammad Laiq committed murder of his daughters Mst. Saima and Mst. Maira suspecting them to be having a bad character, for that the present case was registered.

2. The applicant on having been refused post arrest bail by learned 5th Additional Sessions Judge/MCTC Shaheed Benazirabad has sought for the same from this Court by way of instant application under section 497 Cr.P.C.

3. It is contended by learned counsel for the applicant that the applicant being innocent has been involved in this case falsely by the complainant and no effective role in commission of incident even otherwise is attributed to him; co-accused Ghulam Shabbir with similar role has already been admitted to pre-arrest bail by Hon'ble Supreme Court of Pakistan and complainant Muhammad Laiq has also recorded no objection to the grant of bail to the applicant by filing his affidavit, therefore, the applicant is entitled to grant of bail on point of further inquiry.

4. Learned Deputy Prosecutor General, Sindh for the State who is assisted by the complainant has recorded no objection to grant of bail to the applicant.

5. I have considered the above arguments and perused the record.

6. No effective role in commission of incident is attributed to the applicant. His involvement in commission of incident, on point of vicarious liability obviously is calling for further inquiry.

7. In view of above, the applicant is admitted to bail subject to his furnishing surety in sum of Rs.200,000/- (Rupees Two Lacs) and PR bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court.

8. The instant bail application is disposed of accordingly.
