This petition has already been disposed of on 05.05.2011. Petitioner claimed to have applied for 2% quota, however, he is not a position to place on record a single application to demonstrate that on the basis of an advertisement on 09.08.2007, he has ever applied for such limited quota as being differently abled person. He has relied on an application which he has submitted along with the statement on 22.4.2019, which application shows that it was submitted on 08.05.2012. This application along with the assessment certificate of the petitioner that concerns with his left eye, would not be considered since it is a belated application and it cannot be ascertained that he, in pursuance of an earlier advertisement referred above, has ever applied under differently abled persons quota, hence we cannot, on the basis of this application, which is being considered as an application under Section 151 CPC, direct the official respondents to appoint him on the basis of such disability. This is neither a contempt of Court nor any discretion is required in this regard since the petitioner himself has not come forward along with all requisite codal formalities, which he claimed to have filed. No such application on the basis differently abled quota was submitted along with the documents attached with the memo of petition, hence the application is dismissed.
