Through the instant petition, Petitioner Zulfiqar Hussain has prayed for the grant of Letter of Administration in respect of immovable property/asset, details whereof are mentioned in the Schedule of Property attached with the memo of petition, available at page 15, which was left by his deceased father, namely, Lal Hussain s/o. Muhammad Hussain, who allegedly died on 11.05.2016 at Karachi, leaving behind (1) Mst. Khursheed Begum (widow), (2) Babar Hussain (son), (3) Iftikhar Hussain (son), (4) Aijaz Hussain (son), Zulfiqar Hussain (son/petitioner) and (6) Shazia Begum (daughter) as his legal heirs. Original Death Certificate of deceased as well as photostat copies of Family Registration Certificate, issued by the NADRA and title documents of the immovable property are also filed at page 11-A, 13 and 21 to 33.

Legal heirs No. 1 to 4 and 6 have filed their affidavits of no objection for the grant of Letter of Administration in favour of the petitioner.

Two witnesses, namely, Muhammad Kashif s/o. Muhammad Iqbal and Sajid Ali s/o. Khushi Muhammad have also filed their respective affidavits and affirmed that there is no other legal heir of

the deceased except mentioned above. Their affidavits are also available on record.

Notice of this petition was published in Daily "Jang" Karachi dated 22.01.2019; however, none has filed any objection to the grant of Letter of Administration to petitioner, as per the report submitted by the Deputy Registrar (OS) on 07.02.2019.

Today petitioner as well as legal heirs No. 1 to 4 & 6 and above named witnesses are present. They affirm the contents of memo of petition and their affidavits and also verify their signatures thereon.

Since all the legal formalities/requirements have been fulfilled, there is no impediment in grant of Letter of Administration to petitioner, therefore, the petition is allowed. The office is directed to issue Letter of Administration in respect of immovable property/asset shown in the Schedule of Property, as per rules.
