Through the instant petition, petitioner Asma Mahmood Khan has prayed for the grant of Letter of Administration in respect of immovable property/asset, details whereof are mentioned in the Schedule of Property attached with the memo of petition, available at page 19, which was left by his deceased mother, namely, Rafia Mahmood Khan, who allegedly died on 30th December, 2020 at Karachi, leaving behind her three legal heirs, details whereof are mentioned in paragraph No. 3 of the memo of petition. Original Death Certificate of deceased Rafia Mahmood Khan as well as photostat copies of Death Certificate of deceased father of the petitioner, namely, Ghulam Mehmood Khan, Family Registration Certificate, issued by the NADRA and title documents of the immovable property are also filed at page 13, 15, 17 and 29 to 42

Legal heirs No. 2 & 3 have filed their Affidavits of No-Objection for the grant of Letter of Administration in favour of the petitioner/legal heir No.1. They have also executed Special Power of Attorney duly authenticated by the Notary Public at Karachi in favour of the petitioner.

Two witnesses, namely, Syed Masood Ahmed and Muhammad Siddiq Saleem Qureshi have also filed their respective affidavits and

affirmed that there is no other legal heir of the deceased except mentioned above. Their affidavits are also available on record.

Notice of this petition was published in Daily "Jang" Karachi dated 20th January, 2021; however, none has filed any objection to the grant of Letter of Administration to petitioner, as per the report submitted by the Deputy Registrar (OS) on 11th February, 2021.

Today petitioner as well as above named witnesses are present. They affirm the contents of memo of petition as well as their affidavits and also verify their signatures made thereon.

Since all the legal formalities/requirements have been fulfilled, there is no impediment in grant of Letter of Administration to petitioner, therefore, the petition is allowed. The office is directed to issue Letter of Administration in respect of immovable property/asset shown in the Schedule of Property, as per rules.
