Through the instant petition, petitioner Mst. Shabana Murshid has prayed for the grant of Succession Certificate and Letter of Administration in respect of moveable and immovable properties/assets, details whereof are mentioned in the Schedule of Properties attached with the memo of petition, available at page 29-31, which were left by his deceased husband, namely, Syed Murshid Pervez, who allegedly died on 20th November, 2018 at Karachi, leaving behind him four legal heirs, details whereof are mentioned in paragraph No. 2 of the memo of petition. Original Death Certificate of deceased as well as photostat copies of Family Registration Certificate, issued by the NADRA, title documents of the immovable property and bank statements are also filed at page 19, 21 and 39 to 43.

Legal heirs No. 2 to 4 have filed their Affidavits of No-Objection for the grant of Succession Certificate and Letter of Administration in favour of the petitioner/legal heir No.1, which are available on record.

Two witnesses, namely, Syed Aamir Moid and Muhammad Ahsan Inamullah have also filed their respective affidavits and affirmed that there is no other legal heir of the deceased except mentioned above. Their affidavits are also available on record.

Notice of this petition was published in Daily "Jang" Karachi dated 25th January, 2021; however, none has filed any objection to the grant of

Succession Certificate and Letter of Administration to petitioner, as per the report submitted by the Deputy Registrar (OS) on 11th February, 2021.

Today petitioner and legal heirs No. 2 to 4 as well as above named witnesses are present. They affirm the contents of memo of petition as well as their affidavits and also verify their signatures made thereon.

Since all the legal formalities/requirements have been fulfilled, there is no impediment in grant of Succession Certificate and Letter of Administration to petitioner, therefore, the petition is allowed. The office is directed to issue Succession Certificate and Letter of Administration in respect of movable and immovable properties/assets shown in the Schedule of Properties, as per rules.
