Through the instant petition, petitioner Faisal Hameed has prayed for the grant of Succession Certificate and Letter of Administration in respect of moveable and immovable properties/assets, details whereof are mentioned in the Schedule of Properties attached with the memo of petition, available at page 21, which were left by his deceased father, namely, Abdul Hameed s/o. Noor Dad, who allegedly died on 17<sup>th</sup> May, 2019 at Karachi, leaving behind (1) Mst. Tayaba (daughter), (2) Asim Hameed (son), (3) Faisal Hameed (son/petitioner) and Asif Hameed (son) as his legal heirs. Original Death Certificate of deceased as well as photostat copies of Family Registration Certificate, issued by the NADRA, title documents of the immovable properties, Bank Statements and Saving Certificates are also filed at page 15, 19 and 27 to 129.

Legal heirs No. 1, 2 & 4 have filed their Affidavits of No-Objection for the grant of Succession Certificate and Letter of Administration in favour of the petitioner.

Two witnesses, namely, Tahir Mehmood s/o. Muhammad Farooq and Mehmood Alam s/o. Makhdoom Alam have also filed their respective affidavits and affirmed that there is no other legal heir of the deceased except mentioned above. Their affidavits are also available on record.

Notice of this petition was published in Daily "Jang" Karachi, Lahore and Rawalpindi dated 22<sup>nd</sup> November, 2019; however, none has filed any objection to the grant of Succession Certificate and Letter of Administration to petitioner, as per the report submitted by the Deputy Registrar (OS) on 5<sup>th</sup> December, 2019.

On 2<sup>nd</sup> October, 2019 legal heir No. 2 made his appearance before this Court, while petitioner and legal heirs No. 1 & 4 as well above named witnesses have appeared today. All have affirmed the contents of memo of petition as well as their respective affidavits and also verified their signatures made thereon.

Since all the legal formalities/requirements have been fulfilled, there is no impediment in grant of Succession Certificate and Letter of Administration to petitioner, therefore, the petition is allowed. The office is directed to issue Succession Certificate and Letter of Administration in respect of movable and immovable properties/assets shown in the Schedule of Properties, as per rules.
