Through the instant petition, petitioner Mst. Farida Ahmed has prayed for the grant of Letter of Administration in respect of immoveable property/asset, details whereof are mentioned in the Schedule of Property attached with the memo of petition, available at page 23, which was left by her deceased mother, namely, Mst. Zaibunnisa Begum, who allegedly died on 18<sup>th</sup> February, 2018 at Karachi, leaving behind her five (5) legal heirs, details whereof are mentioned in paragraph No. 5 of the memo of petition. Notice of this petition was published in Daily "Jang" Karachi dated 9<sup>th</sup> November, 2020; however, none has filed any objection to the grant of Letter of Administration to petitioner, as per the report submitted by the Deputy Registrar (OS) on 26<sup>th</sup> November, 2020.

Today petitioner and legal heirs No. 2, 3 and 5 as well as above named witnesses are present. They affirm the contents of memo of petition as well as their affidavits and also verify their signatures made thereon.

Since all the legal formalities/requirements have been fulfilled, there is no impediment in grant of Letter of Administration to petitioner, therefore, the petition is allowed. The office is directed to issue Letter of Administration in respect of immovable property/asset shown in the Schedule of Property, as per rules.
