This Petition involved a dispute regarding allotment of official accommodations, as Respondent No.6 was holding possession despite no Allotment Order in her favour; however, through order dated 28.03.2018, this Petition was disposed of with certain directions along with CP No. 1158 of 2017. It appears that suddenly on 05.11.2020, this Petition came with some other bunch of Petitions along with leading Petition No.414 of 2019 which apparently had no nexus with instant petition as it already stood disposed of. We made a query from learned Counsel for the petitioner and he is unable to assist us in any manner. We also called for cause list of such date and again we are unable to see any nexus or order whereby this petition could be tagged or fixed along with CP No.414 of 2019 and other bunch of petitions. This all has gone unexplained. This has resulted in passing of common orders from 05.11.2020 onwards wherein various directions have been issued. It further appears that insofar as, other connected petitions are concerned, some of them have already served their purposes and have been disposed of; whereas some have been withdrawn.

Be that as it may, since this Petition already stands disposed of vide order dated 28.03.2018 along with CP No.1158 of 2017; therefore, it is directed to be consigned to record; whereas official Respondents and other agencies to whom directions have been issued from time to time shall make compliance of such orders. If any person is further aggrieved, he may seek appropriate remedy, as may be available to him in accordance with law.
