Through the instant petition, petitioner Ayaz Nawab has prayed for the grant of Letter of Administration in respect of immoveable properties/assets, details whereof are mentioned in the Schedule of Properties attached with the memo of petition, available at page 25, which were left by his deceased father, namely, Nawab Khan, who allegedly died on 13<sup>th</sup> May, 2020 at Karachi, leaving behind him fifteen (15) legal heirs, details whereof are mentioned in paragraph No. 3 of the memo of petition. Out of them, legal heirs No. 14 & 15 are minors, who are being represented by their mother/legal heir No. 1, who has been appointed as their Guardian-ad-Litem. Original Death Certificate of deceased as well as photostat copies of Family Registration Certificate & "B" Form, issued by the NADRA and title documents of the immovable properties are also filed at page 15, 17 to 23 and 33 to 62.

Legal heirs No. 1 to 9 and 11 to 13 have filed their Affidavits of No-Objection for the grant of Letter of Administration in favour of the petitioner/legal heir No.10, which are available on record.

Two witnesses, namely, Umer Zada and Dilawar Khan have also filed their respective affidavits and affirmed that there is no other legal heir of the deceased except mentioned above. Their affidavits are also available on record.

Notice of this petition was published in Daily “Jang” Karachi dated 23<sup>rd</sup> November, 2020; however, none has filed any objection to the grant of Letter of Administration to petitioner, as per the report submitted by the Deputy Registrar (OS) on 17<sup>th</sup> December, 2020.

Today petitioner and legal heirs No. 1 to 9 and 11 to 13 as well as above named witnesses are present. They affirm the contents of memo of petition as well as their affidavits and also verify their signatures made thereon.

Since all the legal formalities/requirements have been fulfilled, there is no impediment in grant of Letter of Administration to petitioner, therefore, the petition is allowed. The office is directed to issue Letter of Administration in respect of immovable properties/assets shown in the Schedule of Properties, as per rules.
