Petitioner has assailed the judgment and decree dated 24.5.2014 and an order dated 19.08.2015 passed in execution application and has prayed for the dismissal of suit No.20 of 2013. It appears that suit for maintenance bearing Family Suit No.20 of 2013 was decreed.
