This Petition was filed seeking assistance for the Bailiff of the Executing Court in Execution No.07 of 2003 for possession of the Suit property. The same was entertained by this Court and finally through order dated 31-10-2019, it was disposed of with certain directions. Today, reports have been filed by the respondents including respondents No.2, 3 and 4, and it has been informed that pursuant to orders of this Court, the possession of the Suit property including Madarsa, Mosque and Shops has been handed over to the decree holder. Such reports are taken on record. Since the directions stand satisfied, no further orders are required, and if the petitioner is still aggrieved, he may be approach the Executing Court, as apparently, it is the Executing Court who has to enforce the judgment and decree.

It is needless to mention that the petitioner had never arrayed the parties who were before the Executing Court and have filed Civil Revision Application No. S-94 of 2002 against the judgment of the Trial Court and the Appellate Court, wherein from time to time, restraining orders were also passed. It is also a matter of record that Appellate Court had dismissed the Appeal on limitation and not on merits.

Be that as it may, since the order stands complied with, hence, no further order is required. Accordingly, **CMA No.220 of 2020** is **disposed of** and **CMA No.3740 of 2021** stands **dismissed**.
