Mr. Muhammad Iqbal Siyal advocate for appellant.

The only point raised by the appellant is that she being widow of the deceased was not given a chance to file that succession application instead of her, her mother-in-law, deceased's mother filed it. The contention on the above proposition is that had she been allowed to file she would have attempted to have the share of the minors on P.R. Bond. I am afraid the contention is misleading. Mother of the deceased was also entitled to maintain succession application. However, if the appellant is interested in moving such application for maintaining the minors out of interest accrued on the principle amount retained by the court, they may move it which shall be dealt with in accordance with law after notice to all legal heirs. The appeal, however, being misconceived is dismissed along with pending applications.
