Learned counsel for the appellant/complainant submits that the learned trial Court has dismissed the direct complaint of the appellant/complainant without recording the evidence of the complainant and his witnesses but has passed the impugned order in a hasty manner vide dated 22.07.2020, resultantly, the appellant/complainant has been technically knocked-out. He further submits that the appellant/complainant will be satisfied and would not press instant Criminal Acquittal Appeal, if the directions are given to learned trial Court to record the evidence of the complainant and his witnesses and decide the matter on merits.

2. Learned Additional PG appearing for the State recorded his no objection to the above proposal of the learned counsel for the appellant/complainant.

3. In view of the above, with the consent of learned counsel for the appellant/complainant and learned Additional PG for the State, the instant Criminal Acquittal Appeal is dismissed as not pressed along with listed application. However, the learned trial Court is directed to decide the criminal direct complaint filed by the appellant/complainant on merits in accordance with law, after recording evidence of the complainant and his witnesses within a period of 30 (thirty) days, after receipt hereof. The appellant/complainant is directed to produce his witnesses on each and every date of hearing, and no adjournment shall be granted to either party. If the appellant /complainant failed to comply with this order, then the trial Court is at liberty to pass any appropriate orders.
