The applicants being accused by way of instant Criminal Transfer Application under Section 526 Cr.P.C has sought for transfer of his case from the Court of learned 3rd Additional Sessions Judge, Mirpur Mathelo to any other competent Court of law having jurisdiction mainly for the reasons that the learned trial Judge is pressurizing the applicants to settle the matter with the complainant party, otherwise they will be convicted. It is further alleged that the applicants are also being disgraced, humiliated and insulated at the hands of learned trial Judge; as such the applicants have lost faith to get the justice.

On being asked, as to on what date the applicants were forced to enter into compromise with the complainant party and when they were disgraced, humiliated and insulted at the hands of learned trial Judge? No satisfactory reply to it was furnished by learned counsel for the applicant.

In these circumstances, the grounds taken by applicant are vague and wholly unsubstantiated. The mere allegation is not sufficient to justify transfer unless it is also substantiated by relevant material, which is not the case in hand. No ground, therefore, justifying transfer is made out. Consequently, the instant Criminal Transfer Application along with listed applications being misconceived stands dismissed in limine.
