**ORDER**

**Muhammad Junaid Ghaffar, J**;- Through this Petition, the Petitioner has sought the following reliefs;-

*(a) That this Honourable Court may kindly be pleased to direct the Respondent to recheck the paper of Petitioner and submit report before this Honourable Court.*

*(b) That this Honourable Court may kindly be pleased to direct the respondent not to take any adverse action against the Petitioner till disposal of the instant petition.*

On 08-12-2021, the Petitioner who appears in person was confronted as to the maintainability of this Petition, as apparently he has failed in the aptitude test. Today again he is not in position to assist us in any manner.

On perusal of the record, it appears that the Petitioner appeared in an aptitude test conducted by Respondent No.5 for the post of Junior Elementary School Teacher and as per his own plea, he has failed in the said test. In that case, no vested right is created in favour of the Petitioner

to seek enforcement of any fundamental right, through this Constitutional Petition. Even otherwise, neither he has stated in the memo of Petition as to why and on what ground any rechecking of his test paper can be ordered. Even otherwise; if this kind of Petition is entertained then every applicant would come up with a Petition for rechecking of their test papers. In view of such position, this Petition being misconceived is hereby dismissed with pending Applications.
