Through this bail application, applicant Bashir Ahmed Memon son of Muhammad Siddique seeks bail in FIR No.61of 2020 registered at Police Station Memon Goth, Karachi for offence punishable under Sections 269/270 R/w Section 337-J PPC.

Learned counsel for applicant contended that the applicant is innocent and has falsely been implicated by the complainant with malafide intentions and ulterior motive. He further contended that Sections 269/270 and 273 PPC are bailable whereas section 337-J PPC does not attract the offence narrated in the FIR. He therefore, submits that the bail granted to the applicant may be confirmed.

Learned Deputy Prosecutor General submitted that a big quantity of gottka purias which were lying in the cabin of applicant were recovered from possession his possession who was selling the same and an amount of sale proceeds in the sum of Rs.13,200/- was also recovered. He submitted that though sale of gottka was ban, however it is very dangerous for human life which ultimately causes cancer to the people, therefore, selling gottka is a heinous crime as the applicant plays with the lives of people for his personal gain. He therefore, submitted that the applicant is not entitled for any concession.

I have heard the arguments of learned Counsel for the applicant, the learned Additional Prosecutor General and have gone through the record.

Since Sections 269/270 and 273 PPC are bailable whereas Section 337-J PPC does not attract the offence narrated in the FIR, therefore, I admit the applicant to bail subject to his furnishing solvent surety in the sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) and P.R. Bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Nazir of the trial Court.

The bail application stands disposed of in the above terms.
