- 2. Through this application the counsel for the Appellant seeks review of the order dated 14.02.2019. As per the counsel, on the date when the order was passed, he was very upset due to the health condition of his father and could not assist the Court properly.

Counsel for the Appellant has been heard. It is seen that not a single illegality or infirmity has been pointed out in the order dated 14.02.2019 by the learned counsel for the Appellant. The only ground taken by him was with regard to his not feeling well on the said date. The said stance now taken by learned counsel appears to be wholly misconceived as if he was not feeling well on the said date, he could have easily asked the Court for grant of some time, which was not done rather the counsel argued the matter at length and it was only after his arguments that the matter was found to be premature and not maintainable and thereafter was dismissed. Hence the ground now taken by the learned counsel that he was upset on the said date and could not assist the Court properly is found to be nothing but an afterthought on his part hence no lease in this behalf could be given to him now since the order was passed on 14.02.2019 on the basis of



the material available on record and upon ascertaining the facts of the instant matter. This application, therefore, appears to be wholly misconceived and not maintainable and is accordingly dismissed.
