Mr. T.David Lawrence, learned counsel appearing for the respondents No.3 to 9 submits that beside this petition being not maintainable in view of the non-statutory rules, PEPCO/SEPCO Companies have not been impleaded. I have heard the learned counsel, in substance the case that is presented by the counsel that petitioner has been condemned unheard. It is claimed in the petition as well as in the ground that no show cause notice was issued in respect of an alleged misconduct. Mr. David Lawrence submits that though they have not specifically pleaded but if such is the case of the petitioner, the management shall issue them show cause notice within three day from disposal of this petition, once such show cause notice is issued, the petitioner shall submit parawise reply in respect of the alleged misconduct within ten days from the receipt of such show cause notice. Order accordingly. In case of failure to file a reply or in case such reply is filed the management shall be at liberty to take appropriate action in accordance with law. Till such time an action in accordance with law is taken by the respondents, the impugned letter dated 19.05.2018 shall remain suspended. The entire process may not take more than three weeks.
