YOUSUF ALI SAYEED, J. - The Petitioner professes to be the sole proprietor of a concern engaged in the business of construction, and is said to have submitted certain bids in relation to different works for which a Tender was floated by the Respondent No.4 through a Tender Notice published on 18.07.2022. The Petitioner alleges that despite his participation, the Tender was never properly processed and it is said that he was kept in the dark while the works were unlawfully awarded to so-called "blue-eyed Contractors".

Be that as it may, the Petitioner has not given any particular of any such contract(s) or contractor(s), and vide the prayer advanced has in fact sought information as to how many works have been awarded and to whom. Be that as it may, the prayers nonetheless go on to seek that the works awarded be declared to be non-transparent and unlawful and that the tender process be conducted afresh.

Having considered the matter, it is apparent that over and above the pleadings being bereft of the particulars mentioned hereinabove, it is also noteworthy that while addressing complaints to the Respondent No.4 and to the Provincial Mohtasib, the Petitioner has not made any direct approach to the Sindh Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (SPPRA), within whose domain the matter falls. That being so, we are of the view that the approach to this Court under the Constitutional jurisdiction is misconceived, hence, while granting the application for urgency, we hereby dismiss the Petition *in limine*, along with the other miscellaneous applications.
