ORDER

ADNAN-UL-KARIM MEMON, J.- Through instant petition, the petitioners have sought direction to respondents 2 & 3 not to cause any harassment to them and further to provide them legal protection from respondents 4 to 7 and other relatives of petitioner No.1.

Learned counsel submits that the petitioners contracted freewill marriage which caused annoyance to relatives of petitioner No.1 and the official respondents at the instance of private respondents are causing harassment to them, hence they have filed the instant petition.

Contracting marriage is a right of every adult male and female and official respondents are duty bound to provide legal protection to every citizen being their vested right; therefore, if the petitioners approaches them they will be provided protection as per law.

In view of the above, the instant petition is disposed of with direction to the official respondents to act strictly in accordance with law, shall not cause any harassment to petitioners and shall provide legal protection to the petitioners.
