**YOUSUF ALI SAYEED, J.** The captioned Petition under Article 199 of the Constitution has been preferred in the backdrop of the widespread flooding that has recently ensued in the province as a consequence of the unprecedentedly heavy rainfall across the country, with it being alleged that the concerned authorities at the Provincial level are failing to properly address the situation.

On that premise, it has been prayed that the official respondents be directed to release funds amongst the persons affected across the province while produce details of all those persons as well as the “sketch/layout plan” for the precautionary steps that have been taken and the record of the funds provided and disbursed to date.

However, a perusal of the Petition reflects that the pleadings are vague and ambiguous, and while entire matter is predicated on the alleged failure of the official machinery at the Provincial level, no specific instance of such failure has even been cited. Under such circumstances, no case for issuance of writ stands made out, and the Petition is accordingly dismissed *in limine*, along with the other pending miscellaneous applications.
