YOUSUF ALI SAYEED, J- The Petitioner claims to have supplied furniture to the Education and Literacy Department, Province of Sindh in terms of a contract, and has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court under Article 199 of the Constitution seeking release of the amounts said to be due in that regard, with it being alleged that a cheque of Rs. 13,358,422/- had also been issued in that respect, but had been returned when presented for encashment with the endorsement that payment had been stopped by the issuer.

Having the considered the matter, it is manifest that the underlying cause is that of recovery of contractual dues, whereas it is well settled that a Petition under Article 199 of the Constitution is not the appropriate vehicle for such a purpose. That being so, while granting the application for urgency we hereby dismiss the Petition in *limine* along with the other miscellaneous application, leaving the Petitioner at liberty to agitate the claim before the concerned Civil Court.
