<u>ORDER</u>

MUHAMMAD IQBAL KALHORO, J:- During patrolling, the police of P.S. Hussainabad arrested the applicant and his accomplices on 06.04.2022 on suspicion from Railway track near Mehran Mill Hyderabad and recovered different articles from them like Battery, Circuit, wires, pistol etc. From applicant allegedly one Grenade but without fuse was recovered. Learned defence counsel has referred to a copy of application moved by relative of accused before FIR against illegal confinement of accused and press clippings of different newspapers in which confinement of applicant and other accused was reported. Learned counsel citing these facts and circumstances has pleaded for bail, opposed by learned APG.

The case has been challaned and applicant is no more required for further investigation and his incarceration in jail is not beneficial to prosecution in any manner. Learned APG has confirmed that previous to this no case was ever registered against applicant. The Grenade allegedly recovered from applicant was without fuse and its functionality is therefore yet to be determined by learned trial Court. Accordingly, this bail application is allowed and the applicant is granted post-arrest bail subject to furnishing solvent surety in the sum of Rs.100,000/- (One lac rupees) and P.R Bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of learned trial Court. Learned trial Court is directed to expedite the trial and conclude the same within a period of three months and submit compliance report.

The observations made hereinabove are tentative in nature and shall not influence the trial Court while deciding the case on merits.
