**YOUSUF ALI SAYEED, J.** The Petitioner claims to be a Medical Practitioner and alleges that he is being subjected to unlawful demands by the functionaries of the Healthcare Commission, who are said to be obstructing his practice while seeking illegal gratification. However, as it transpires, no documents have been placed on record to demonstrate that the Petitioner has a valid registration with the Commission, nor has it been shown that proper steps have been taken to pursue the matter before the concerned Law Enforcement Agencies, other than a cursory letter said to have been written to the Director, Anti-Corruption, Sindh, Karachi, that too bearing the very date on which the instant Petition happens to have been instituted. Under the given circumstances, the Petition is found to be misconceived and stands dismissed accordingly.
