Amjad Ali Sahito, J:- Through instant bail application, the applicants/accused namely, Barir @ Babar Khoso, Irshad Ali and Meer Hassan seek pre-arrest bail in Crime No.06/2023, registered at Police Station Coal Mines, District Jamshoro for the offence under sections 324, 337-A (iii), 337-A (iv), 506/2, 504, 147, 148, 149 PPC. Earlier the bail plea of the applicants/accused was declined by the learned Additional Sessions Judge-II, Kotri vide order dated 28.02.2023.

2. The details and particulars of the FIR are already available in the bail application and FIR, the same could be gathered from the copy of the FIR attached with such application, hence, needs not to reproduce the same hereunder.

3. Learned counsel for the applicants has mainly argued that the applicants/accused are innocent and have falsely been implicated in this case. However, he argued that all the sections are compoundable, the parties have patched up and compromised the matter outside the Court and complainant has no objection for confirmation of bail. He, therefore, prayed for grant of bail to the applicants/accused.

4. On the other hand, learned counsel for the complainant has affirmed the contentions of learned counsel for the applicants/accused that the compromise has arrived at between the parties and the complainant has no objection, if the interim pre-arrest bail already granted to the applicants/accused. Learned A.P.G. Sindh has also raised no objection.

5. Heard and perused the record.

6. In view of the above, since all the sections are compoundable; the parties have entered into compromise; there is no objection on behalf of complainant as well as learned A.P.G. Sindh, the instant criminal bail application is **allowed** and the interim pre-arrest bail already granted to the applicants/accused by this Court vide order dated 11.04.2023 is hereby confirmed on the same terms and conditions laid down therein.
