ORDER.

YOUSUF ALI SAYEED, J- The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court under Article 199 of the Constitution arraying the Province of Sindh and functionaries of the Police Department as the Respondent Nos.1 to 5, as well as various private persons as the Respondents No.6 to 11, while asserting a dispute as between him and those private Respondents in the context of a family matter pertaining to the erstwhile marriage of his father with the Respondent No.7, and it is being prayed in that backdrop that this Court be pleased;-

a). To direct the official respondents not to register any false case against the petitioner party on the instance of private respondents, so also direct the respondent No.2 to provide protection to the petitioner and his family member.

b). To grant any other alternate relief which this Honourable Court deems fit and proper in the circumstances of the case.

Having considered the matter, the Petition is found to be misconceived as the Respondents cannot be restrained from performing their statutory functions and as the falsity of a criminal case would properly to be fall to be determined through an investigation following registration of the first information report. Furthermore, as regards the prayer for protection, it is apparent from the record that an order has already been made in that regard by the Justice of Peace.

In view of the foregoing, the Petition stands dismissed accordingly.
