Learned counsel for appellants concedes that this is a time barred appeal. No plausible explanation has been provided in the affidavit filed in support of application under section 5 of the Limitation Act (CMA No.34/2018) as it is only stated that they were under the belief/impression that perhaps costs of funds will not be granted.

Section 22 of Financial Institutions (Recovery of Finances) Ordinance, 2001 provides time of 30 days whereas this appeal has been filed belatedly. Law sets the requirement for cost of funds hence there is no question of any presumption. Learned counsel has conceded that affidavit filed in support of the application for condonation of delay does not provide any plausible ground to condone such delay. Since appeal is barred by time, as conceded by learned counsel for appellants, the application under section 5 of Limitation Act (CMA No.34/2018) is dismissed and in consequence whereof appeal also stands dismissed, as being barred by time, along with pending applications.
