YOUSUF ALI SAYEED, J. - The Petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court under Article 199 of the Constitution in the backdrop of six FIRs said to have been registered at different Police Stations across the Province, with the ensuing cases said to be pending before the concerned Courts. The grievance espoused by the petitioner is that the relevant police functionaries have not been able to secure the arrest of the persons accused, who are shown as absconders in the proceedings before the trial Courts. As such, it has been prayed that this Court be pleased to issue directions to the respondents to constitute a team for the arrest of such absconders and produce them before the concerned Courts of law for facing the trial.

Upon consideration, the case of the Petitioner is found to be misconceived as the Code of Criminal Procedure presents a complete framework to be followed by the concerned Court in such matters, and it does not fall to this Court to regulate such matters in exercise of its writ jurisdiction. That being so, the Petition stands dismissed in *limine*, along with the pending miscellaneous application.
