**Irshad Ali Shah, J**;- It is alleged that the applicant with rest of the culprits in furtherance of their common intention being member of gang of thieves associated to commit robbery/dacoity and then deterred the police party of PS Ubauro led by ASI Allah Jiwayo Rind from discharging its lawful duty as public servant by making fires at them with intention to commit their murder and then made their escape good, for that the present case was registered.

2. The applicant on having been refused Pre-Arrest bail by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ubauro, has sought for the same from this Court by way of instant Crl. Bail Application under Section 498-A Cr.P.C.

3. Heard arguments and perused the record.

4. There is no independent witness to the incident. The identity of the applicant on the light of vehicles is appearing to be weak piece of evidence. The firing allegedly made at the time of incident proved to be in effective one. The case has finally been challaned; applicant has joined the trial and there is no allegation of misusing the concession of interim pre arrest bail on his part. In these circumstances, a case for grant of pre-arrest bail in favour of the applicant on point of further inquiry malafide obviously is made out.

5. In view of above, the interim pre-arrest bail already granted to the applicant is confirmed on the same terms and conditions.

6. The instant Crl. Bail Application is disposed of accordingly.
