MUHAMMAD KARIM KHAN AGHA J.- Applicants Syed Deen Muhammad, Khalid and Ghulam Mustafa Jamali have been booked in Crime No.13 of 2023 registered at P.S Bhan Saeedabad under Sections 324, 506(2), 147, 148, 149, 114, 504, 337-A(i), 337-F(i), 337-F(vi) and 337-H(ii) PPC, which is proceeding before learned Additional Sessions Judge Sehwan. They had applied for pre-arrest bail before the learned trial Court, however, same was declined vide Order dated 12.08.2023, hence they have approached this Court for pre-arrest bail.

2. Brief facts of the case as per FIR lodged by complainant Sadam Hussain are that on 24.02.2023 allegedly the applicants alongwith co-accused following a dispute with the complainant party made fire upon Fahad, who became injured hence aforesaid FIR was lodged.

3. I have heard the learned counsel for the applicants, learned counsel for the complainant (Sadam Hussain who is also present) as well as learned A.P.G and have also perused the record.

4. Learned counsel for the applicants as well as learned counsel for the complainant state that parties are in the process of settlement, as such

complainant has no objection for grant of bail to the applicants. Learned A.P.G states that under these circumstances she did not oppose the grant of pre-arrest bail to the applicants.

5. Since the complainant himself has stated that the matter is being patched up between them and the applicants are regularly attending the trial, therefore, rejection of pre-arrest bail of the applicants will serve no purpose. Accordingly interim pre-arrest bail granted to the applicants vide Orders dated 23.08.2023 and 28.08.2023 respectively is confirmed on the same terms and conditions.

6. Needless to mention here that observations made hereinabove are tentative in nature and will not prejudice the case of either party at trial.

7. Captioned bail applications stand disposed of accordingly.
