After arguing the matter at some length and while confronted as to maintainability of instant petition, particularly in view of the fact that the Ordinance upon which the reliance is being placed and the directions are being sought in respect of complaint made under Section 4 of the Protection of Parents Ordinance, 2021, which appears to have been lapsed, whereas, an FIR has already been registered by the petitioner against his sons, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press instant petition and submits that he will pursue his remedy available under the law.

Accordingly, instant Constitutional Petition is dismissed as not pressed alongwith listed application. It is, however, expected that the authority where petitioner has instituted legal proceedings, including police, shall provide protection to the petitioner in accordance with law.
