On 28.09.2022, all these petitions were disposed of in the terms whereby Selection Committee was directed to consider the case of petitioners, 46 in number, for regularization of their service on merit basis.

It appears that Selection Committee interviewed and examined the credentials of all the petitioners and found twenty six (26), out of them, eligible for regularization. However, meanwhile, listed applications for contempt were filed. In response, a statement has been filed along with recommendations of Selection Committee enumerating names of twenty six (26) candidates/petitioners in tabular form.

Learned Counsel for respondents-Workers Welfare Board, who is present today, undertakes that within one month, in the light of recommendations of Selection Committee, service of all the twenty six (26) candidates/petitioners will be regularized and such orders would be issued to them. Learned Counsel for petitioners are satisfied and we are also satisfied that material compliance has been made; hence, listed **contempt applications** are **disposed of**. However, the petitioners, who were not found eligible by Selection Committee, may avail their remedy in accordance with law.
