Muhammad Iqbal Kalhoro, J. – There is a dispute between the parties, who are co-villagers. On the day of incident viz. 26.06.2023, applicant along with five (05) other accused duly named in FIR, barged into house of complainant duly armed with iron rods and hatchets. Applicant was armed with a hatchet and he caused injury to complainant so also other accused, and his daughter Asma. Then, on intervention of witnesses, they left the house; hence FIR.

- 2. Learned Counsel for the applicant has chosen to remain absent. I have heard the applicant in person and the Counsel holding brief on behalf of his Advocate.
- 3. Learned DPG submits that complainant had received six (06) injuries and all are bailable except 337-F(v) PPC, which is punishable for 05 years, and it is not mentioned in the FIR that as to who had caused that injury to the complainant. Mst. Asma had also received an injury: 337-F(v) PPC at the hand of applicant, but there is a delay of more than one month in registration of FIR viz. on 01.08.2023; hence, he has no objection.

- 4. The dispute between the parties is admitted in FIR and there is a delay of more than one month in its registration; therefore, false implication of the applicant cannot be ruled out. Hence, this application is **allowed**. Accordingly, ad-interim pre-arrest bail already granted to applicant, vide order dated 28.08.2023, is hereby **confirmed** on same terms and conditions.
- 5. The observations made hereinabove are tentative in nature and shall not influence the trial Court while deciding the case on merits.

The bail application stands **disposed of** in the above terms.
